- Conduct first off, in-process and final inspection in accordance with customer specifications and documented quality plan, ensuring checks are carried out accurately and recorded in a timely and efficient manner
- Set up, monitor, test, adjust and correct measurement devices and test equipment using approved industry standards of performance and reliability
- Liaise with counterparts on other shifts to ensure there is continuity
- Participate in the training of personnel in quality related issues
- New process/equipment approval sampling
- Identify non-conformances and failures and initiate corrective actions
- Verify effectiveness of corrective actions implemented
- Participate in continual improvement projects/teams
- Keep equipment and related area clean and tidy; follow 6s guidelines
- Any other duties as reasonably required

- Relevant diploma in Quality/Science or Engineering would be advantageous but is not essential
- Experience in the use of Co-ordinate Measuring Machines (CMM) desirable
